

## Famous Virginian – Who Am I?

---

*Appropriate for grades 4-9.*

**Purpose:** This activity will help students review several famous Virginians.

**Objectives:**

1. Identify the important contributions of each individual.
2. Formulate questions of a very specific nature.

**Activities:**

Each student will have a card taped to his or her back with the name of a famous Virginian. (i.e. Thomas Jefferson, George Washington, Douglas Wilder, George Allen, etc...) The student will not know the name of this person. The student's goal is to try to identify "who they are" by asking questions that can be answered with a "Yes" or a "No" answer.

1. No more than two questions at a time can be asked of any one student.
2. The student must figure out who they are within 20 questions.
3. The student who figures out who he is in the least number of questions is the winner.
